Board of Education Elections: Resources

Three seats will be on the ballot to elect Brown Deer Board of Education Members. *The spring election is held on the first Tuesday in April, <u>Wis. Stat. 5.02(21)</u>, which is Tuesday, April 1, 2025. Winners of these seats will serve three-year terms beginning April 28, 2025.*

Candidates are required to file the following:

- 1. Campaign Finance Registration Statement (CF-1L)
- 2. Declaration of Candidacy (EL-162SD)

The District Office, located at 8200 N. 60th Street, Brown Deer, WI; 53223, shall be the designated filing location for all forms, petitions, oaths of office, and other filings related to the School Board elections. The District Office is open Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The filing office will be closed from November 28-29, 2024; December 24-25, 2024, and December 31, 2024, through January 1, 2025.

The filing office will be open until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 2, 2025, for the candidate filing deadline.

Who is eligible to be a candidate?

All candidates must meet the age and residency requirements established for the office to which they are seeking election. A candidate for school district office must be a qualified elector of the school district at the time of filing a Declaration of Candidacy (EL-162sd). Wis. Stats. \$\$120.05(1)(d), 120.06(2), (6)(b)2. 120.06(7)(a). Therefore, a candidate for school board must

have satisfied the 28-day residency requirement before filing a Declaration of Candidacy (EL-162sd).

Annual Compensation for the School District of Brown Deer Board of Education Members is \$3,100 for 2024-2025.
