The district offers free breakfast and lunch to all summer school participants and Brown Deer community members. Attendance:

Attendance is taken daily. If your child is not at summer school, you must contact our attendance office at **(414) 371-6746**. High School students are only allowed to have two excused absences. High school students are in credit recovery and students must meet a certain amount of minutes and work completion to qualify for credit attainment. If high school students have more than one excused absence, the student will be dropped from the summer school.

Per School Board Policy 2440.01, 90% attendance is expected. This is equal to no more than 2 total absences.

Cost: There is **no cost** for the Brown Deer Middle/High School Summer Learning Program.

Dates: Monday, June 22nd to Wednesday, July 22nd. **No school on Fridays**

Cell Phones: Cell phones are not allowed. Storage will be provided in the office for Middle School or classrooms for High School students.

Drop-off:

Parents are required to offer transportation for their child as bussing will not be available.

Drop-off will begin at 7:45 am every Monday-Thursday during the summer learning program. Please drop off students at the Brown Deer Middle/High School main entrance. A staff member will let your child(ren) into the building for the summer learning program.

Pick-up:

Parents are required to offer transportation for their child as bussing will not be available.

Pick-up will occur at 12 PM, every day, at the Brown Deer Middle/High School main entrance. Pick-up will follow the same structure and routine as the regular school year. Please give yourself some extra time during the first few days of summer school, as everyone will be adjusting to the structure of pick-up and drop-off.

Purpose:

To provide both our middle school and high school students with the opportunity to continue to progress in their learning and make further growth in their skills during the summer. We will continue to inspire our students to be passionate learners, creative thinkers, and innovative leaders.

Focus:

Summer 2026 will provide in-person summer programming for middle and high School students. In middle school, students will spend their days exploring our campus, building, creating, learning, moving, and interacting. High school students in the summer of 2026, will be offering support for students working to complete graduation requirements. We will continue our support of students to complete benchmark assignments and assessments to set up a successful fall of learning.

Eligibility:

Any student who attends the Brown Deer MHS or resides in the Village of Brown Deer may be a part of the summer school learning program.

Format:

Brown Deer Middle School: Students will participate in 3 class periods consisting of the following classes: a Math class, an ELA class, and one Enrichment class. Each class will be approximately one hour in length. Cell phones will be stored in the office during class.

Brown Deer High School students may earn up to one credit towards graduation. Students may take one or both semesters of a course. High school students must complete assigned work and attend at least 18 of the 19 instructional days to earn the credit toward graduation.

Dismissal Policy:

Student participation in summer school is not required in the same way it is during the regular school year. If behavior and attendance rules are broken during the summer school term, then the summer school principal(s) can dismiss a student from the summer learning program. If a student violates summer school and classroom rules and must be removed from the classroom, then the parent/guardian will be contacted. If a second violation occurs, then the student may be dismissed from the summer school program.

Behavior expectations:

Our Summer School program will continue to enforce the Brown Deer Way of being safe, responsible, respectful, honest, and ready to learn.
